IDPH Encourages New Bivalent Booster Shots 30 Illinois counties now in "high" community level

With 30 counties in the state at an elevated level for COVID-19, on Friday the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) urged all who are eligible to take advantage of the new bivalent booster shots that have been authorized by the CDC. The CDC recommends a number of measures for people in areas that are rated at **High** Community Level for COVID-19 transmission. Learn more online.




