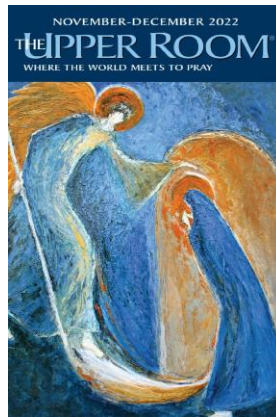
Ladies Lunch

NEW adult clothing, smaller sizes
Diapers, baby wipes, Pedialyte, toys and activity books
NEW children's clothing - socks, underwear, shirts, pants, coats
Pajamas, hats, gloves, shoes (all sizes)
Medications (over the counter, both adult and children) –
Ibuprofen, Tylenol, allergy meds, Tums, Chapstick
Band-Aids, women's sanitary products, razors, deodorants, shampoo

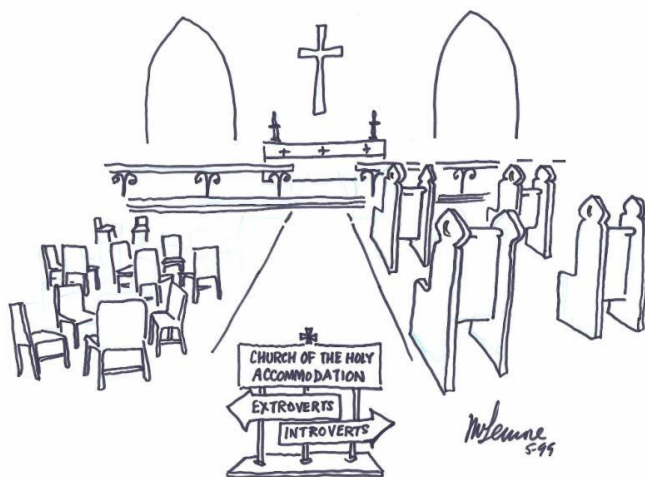
