
My dear friends and members of St. Paul's,

Lifeline Screening Event Tuesday, January 17, 2023

On January 17, Lifeline will be coming to church for a health screening event. St. Paul's has hosted these events in the past, and it is an opportunity to screen for risk factors without going to the doctor's office.

These screenings offer the opportunity to discover the risk for chronic diseases such as atherosclerosis, peripheral arterial disease, or other vascular conditions and are conducted by highly trained sonographers using the same sophisticated ultrasound equipment employed by major hospitals. Results are reviewed and sent to participants to share with their personal physician. More information can be found at <u>lifelinescreening.com</u>.
