Easter Day April 9, 2023

Years ago, at the ordination and consecration of Bishop Eugene Sutton of Maryland, I heard Senate Chaplain Barry Black tell a story that has stayed with me ever since. It goes like this:

There are two guys doing construction work, Joe and Gus. Every day at noon they take a break and eat their packed lunches together. One day, Joe takes out his sandwich and finds tuna fish. "Oh wow," he exclaims. "Tuna fish on rye. My favorite!" Then Gus takes out his sandwich. "Just bologna," he murmurs. "I hate bologna every day." Joe responds, "If you don't like bologna, Gus, tell your wife to stop making bologna sandwiches, and fix something else." Gus looks back at Joe and confesses, "I'm not married, Joe. I fix these bologna sandwiches myself."

The moral of the story, Chaplain Black said, is that we should stop making bologna sandwiches. We are Resurrection People, called by God to do better! Today we celebrate the completely unexpected, unimaginable miracle of the Resurrection—the miracle that compels us to stop doing the same old things—like making bologna sandwiches we don't really want to eat!—and draws us into new life. Like the women who went to the tomb to encounter a miracle they could not imagine, Easter morning brings us a fresh chance to experience the power of God that takes hold when we let go of what no longer serves us and take a chance on what might come next.

This Easter, God is calling us to reimagine our ministry, to rebuild our congregations and communities and to seize an unexpected, amazing second chance at ministry. Like Mary at the tomb, we can take the risk to be surprised, even when we think all is lost, and preach the Good News in ways we never could have imagined. So this year, join me in making an Easter commitment: Together, let's stop making bologna sandwiches and start being the Resurrection People that God longs for us to be.

Alleluia, Christ is Risen!
