Wear Orange on Sunday, June 4

On January 21, 2013, Hadiya Pendleton marched in President Obama's second inaugural parade. One week later, Hadiya was shot and killed on a playground in Chicago. Soon after this tragedy, Hadiya's childhood friends decided to commemorate her life by wearing orange, the color hunters wear in the woods to protect themselves and others.

Wear Orange began on June 2, 2015—what would have been Hadiya's 18th birthday. Since then, Wear Orange has expanded to a period of three days each year: National Gun Violence Awareness Day (the first Friday in June) and Wear Orange Weekend (the accompanying weekend). This year, Wear Orange will take place from June 2-4, 2023.

Orange has become the defining color of the gun violence prevention movement. New York gun violence prevention advocate Erica Ford spearheaded orange as the color of peace through her work with her organization, Life Camp, Inc. Whether it's worn by students in Montana, activists in New York, or Hadiya's loved ones in Chicago, the color orange honors the more than 120 lives cut short and the hundreds more wounded by gun violence **every day.**

One & Done Outreach Opportunity!

Our sister churches, St. Mary's and St. Ann's, have formed a Migrant Ministry Team to address some of the needs supporting migrant advocacy organizations in Illinois. While the needs are many, at this time St. Mary's and St. Ann's are addressing some immediate needs requested by the Illinois Migrant Council (IMC). IMC is a community-based non-profit organization with the primary mission of promoting employment, education, health, housing and other opportunities for migrant and seasonal farmworkers (MSFW) and their families to achieve economic self-sufficiency and stability.

The Vestry recently agreed to partner with St. Mary's and St. Ann's as part of St. Paul's "One & Done" Ministry. For the next couple of weeks, we will be placing our Moses Baskets in the Narthex and, once again, ask you to fill up those baskets with the most basic of needs for the women and children of these displaced migrant and seasonal workers.

Here is the list of most needed women's and children's necessities:

Diapers, diaper cream, baby wash (adult & baby) Sanitizing Wipes, sanitary napkins, tampons Formula, bottles, pacifiers, rattles 12 month sleepers & T-shirts Deodorant, toothpaste, floss

We will be collecting items THIS SUNDAY June 4 ONLY.
