Early/absentee voting at St. Mary's during office hours

Our Saturday, May 4 special parish meeting is just a week and a half away! Though inperson attendance is strongly recommended so that we can pray together and hear from one another, those who *cannot* attend in person on May 4 may vote early. Early voting can happen:

PLEASE NOTE!

100% participation is encouraged: because of the way votes are counted in special parish elections, a non-vote counts as a "no" vote. Two-thirds of EACH church's total voting members must vote "yes" for the measure to pass.

As we continue to work toward becoming a multisite Episcopal parish for McHenry County, we are gathering and detailing a great deal of information. Midweek Mass (Rite 1) at St. Mary's, Crystal Lake

Midweek Mass is a simple, spoken service using traditional language (also known as Rite 1). The service begins promptly at noon and lasts around 30 minutes. This is an excellent, simple discipline to help you pause midweek and remember God's work in your life. This service is also a good way to experience a new type of Eucharist if you've never heard a traditional language Mass, or to revisit the traditional-language Eucharists of earlier years if you are a long-time Episcopalian. **Midweek Mass will continue through May 15 and will pick up again in the fall.**
