On Saturday, May 4, members of St. Paul's (McHenry), St. Mary's (Crystal Lake) and St. Ann's (Woodstock) gathered at the St. Mary's campus for a special parish meeting. More than 100 were in attendance on Saturday, and others cast votes during early voting. The voting members of the three parishes overwhelmingly adopted the resolution that authorizes the consolidation of the three parishes into a single parish with two campuses: one in Woodstock (St. Ann's) and one in Crystal Lake (St. Mary's).

Pending diocesan approval and filing with the Illinois Secretary of State's office, **the consolidation will take effect on January 1, 2025.**

Election Results by Parish

St. Paul's, McHenry

(23 eligible voters)

Yes: 23 No: 0 Abstain: 0

St. Mary's, Crystal Lake

(55 eligible voters)

Yes: 53 No: 0 Abstain: 2

St. Ann's, Woodstock

(82 eligible voters)

Yes: 78 No: 1 Abstain: 3

Participation of our voting members was very high: only 5 voters abstained or were unable to vote out of 160 voters. Thank you for your participation in this important decision!

What happens next?

In the short term, not much will change. Worship will continue at all three parishes, as usual, and we will continue our programs and outreach. There will be occasional times when we will gather for shared events, like worship or social gatherings (just like we do already). Mostly, though, **we stay focused on following Jesus and serving God's people.**

In the meantime:

- The results of this election will be shared with the Bishop's Office and Diocesan Convention in November. At the convention, we will be admitted as a new parish (effective January 1).
- The chancellors (attorneys) of the diocese will work with the leadership of our parishes on the legal paperwork to consolidate the parishes into a single legal entity.
- Later this year, other groups will work on the logistics of the transition as we prepare for January 1.

The clergy and vestries will make every effort to keep the congregations informed along the way. Please feel free to reach out with questions or comments.


